3. When using our rental skates, please ask for the black rental figure skates. Please do not put any new skater in hockey skates. Hockey skates are recommended for skaters in Snowplow Sam 3 or Basic 2 and higher. Skates should be laced tightly through the top of the foot and ankle. Ask for help if you need it!
